

Help Shape the New Harriet Elizabeth Brown Community Center & Park

Deadline Extended – Fill Out the Community Survey before June 30!

The Calvert County Department of Parks & Recreation is asking both adults and students to tell them what to include in the planned Harriet Elizabeth Brown Community Center and Park in Prince Frederick. This *permanent* facility – just across from Calvert High School – will provide more than the typical “community center” activities. It will also have expanded outdoor opportunities, from trails and picnic areas to recreation and outdoor meeting spaces. It will replace the *temporary* HEB Community Center on Dares Beach Road.



The new HEB Community Center & Park will serve citizens county-wide, not just Prince Frederick – from Dunkirk and Owings to Lusby and Solomons. It is named after Calvert own’s Harriet Elizabeth Brown – a teacher who, in 1937 and represented by a 29-year-old NAACP attorney named Thurgood Marshall, successfully challenged unequal pay for African-American teachers in Calvert County.
